General comments:	Parent meetings in school today. On walk through school excellent displays of children's work seen. Half of Reception children were in Redcliffe's celebrating Pancake Day – enjoying making and eating them. The rest of Reception were in classroom working on challenges or in areas of learning. All busy and engaged. In Nursery children were also celebrating Pancake Day with pancake making activities both inside and outside.
Summary of what was learned:	Many areas of curriculum displayed on corridor for children and visitors to look at and celebrate. Reception and Nursery areas of learning engaging children where they can develop their own ideas. Reception children taken to Redcliffe's Kitchen to make pancakes – all very excited and could tell me what ingredients they had used. Parent meetings working well with staff having time out of class to do this.
