AT BOUNDARY	
 In English this term, KS2 we are developing reading and writing skills with a focus on biographies. We will be writing our own biography about Neil Armstrong. In English this term, KS1 pupils will be looking at a range of texts including Back to Earth with a Bump, Beegu and Aliens Love Underpants. We will also continue to work on our individual spelling and phonics targets. 	In Maths, KS2 pupils will developing our mental maths skills by learning our times tables. We will also be learning to identify and describe the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. In Maths, KS1 pupils will be using more mathematical language such as 'more', 'less' and 'greater'. We will also be learning about number bonds to 10 and 20 as well as learning to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.
There will be continue to be daily PSHE lessons which are adapted to each pupil's individual needs. We will have a whole class focus on building resilience and managing our emotions when things begin to get difficult for us in the classroom.	Our design and technology lessons will be focusing on electronics. This will include looking at technological developments in the way we light our homes, understanding how a series and parallel circuit can be used to light a bulb, how switches can be made and used in circuits, designing, building and evaluating a light for a specific use.
Our Computing lessons will have a focus on using and applying our ICT skills. KS2 pupils will be making their own presentations with interactive elements. KS1 pupils will be using their ICT skills to create different images and drawings.	In History, KS2 will be looking at a chronology of space travel and how and why things have changed over time.
In Science, KS2 will be learning about the Earth and the moon. KS1 pupils will be learning about our planet, Earth.	KS1's history focus is on a significant person in history, which will be Neil Armstrong.
