



## Cedar Summer 2 Olympics



In English this term, KS2 will be learning the techniques for persuasive writing. We will then be writing our own posters for the Tokyo Olympics. We will also be learning various performance poems, looking at techniques to entertain the reader. KS1 pupils will be continuing their work on phonics and how to use their phonics skills in their reading and writing. We will also be creating our own non-fiction writing based on facts from the Olympic Games.

This half term in our PSHE sessions, we will continue with Zones of Regulation. Focusing on strategies to support us regulating our emotions.

We will also be continuing our Wellbeing Wednesdays focusing on different strategies to use when struggling.

In Geography, we will be learning about the host nation of this year's Olympic games – Japan. We will learn about the human and physical geography of this country.

In Maths, KS2 we will be learning about fractions and decimals. We will learn how to count, order, add and subtract these numbers. We will also be learning about position and direction by using coordinates. KS1 pupils will continue counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will then be using our knowledge of money which will involve identifying coins and adding coins.

Our design and technology lessons will be focusing on designing and making sporting equipment. We will use various techniques such as gluing, making hinges and combining materials to strengthen the equipment.

In History, we will be learning about the when and how the Olympics originated and significant events throughout the years.

In Science, we will be learning about forces. We will look at what forces do to objects. We will also learn about magnetic force.
