Key Information:

P.E. - You must have your full PE kit in school on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. This should include pumps or trainers, black shorts and a white T-Shirt.

<u>Forest School</u> - On Thursday 24th June and Thursday 1st July Year 1 will have their final Forest School Sessions of the year. Children will come to school in the uniform on these days and then get changed into their Forest School Kit. On this day the children will get dirty and possibly wet during these sessions, so they will be expected bring to school :

- old trousers
- study shoes/trainers or wellies
- old warm jumpers or fleeces
- waterproof coat and trousers, if possible
- hat and gloves
- extra socks.

<u>**Reading</u>** - Please make sure that you read at least 3 times a week and get your reading diary signed. Books will be changed on a Monday and Thursday. Reading books must be in school <u>every day</u>.</u>

Spellings - Spellings will be tested on a Friday morning and new ones given out on a Friday.

<u>BLT</u>-Homework will be set on a Friday and must be completed by the following Thursday. This will consist of Maths, English and Phonics. You will also get a half termly BLT project with some exciting tasks. This will be due in on Monday 12th July. Please remember that your weekly homework is set on Seesaw. Your log ins are stuck in the front of your reading diary. If you have any problems please call to office or speak to the class teacher.

Isolation: If your child is isolating or their bubble closes, work will be set on Seesaw. Your child's login is inside their reading diary. It is expected that your child's work is completed
