

Welcome to the third issue of our newsletter in connection with the proposed housing development on Grange Park, Blackpool.

The project comprises the construction of 131 residential dwellings; consisting of 96 houses, 5 bungalows and 30 apartments, in partnership with Blackpool Council and Blackpool Coastal Housing.

The project will be split into two phases spanning over the course of three years. Works to Phase 1 (Dinmore Avenue Site) have commenced, preparation works to Phase 2 will start in September.

Site A (Phase 2) - Chepstow Road.

- -Site Strip and cart away from 5th Sept.
- -Perimeter Fencing On-going

Site B (Phase 1) - Dinmore Avenue.

- -Estate roads constructed to sub-base level
- -Main drainage to the site installed
- -Piling will continue followed by sub-substructure masonry, then floor beams and screeding
- -Cranes on site for first timber frames to be erected


