## Physical Development Moving and Handling Health and Self Care

We will be developing our physical skills inside and outdoors.

We will be practicing holding our pencils and other tool correctly

We will be continuing to develop our independence by putting on our own coats and outdoor wear including our wellington boots by ourselves

We will be talking about and developing an understanding of what contributes to good health.

### Mathematics Number

We will be using natural objects to count out up to six objects from a larger group. We will be finding one more one less from a group of up to five objects and 10 objects. We will be selecting the correct numeral to represent 1-5 and then 1-10 objects.

Shape, Space and Measure

We will be ordering two or three items by length, height or capacity in Santa's Workshop We will be exploring and recognising 2D and 3D shapes at school, home and the environment

## Understanding the World

We will be talking about things we do at home and use role play opportunities based on our own experiences and interests.

We will be looking closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change including the weather and by exploring the outdoor environment.

We will be using a variety of technology available in school successfully.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning how to resolve conflicts with other children, e.g. finding a compromise.

We will be talking about ourselves confidently and talk about what we are good at

We will be beginning to understand how our own behaviours affect other people, for example, children may become upset and try to comfort another child when they realise they have upset them.

# Expressive Art and Design

We will be selecting tools and techniques needed to shape, assemble and join materials to make a variety of things e.g clay hedgehogs and animal homes.

We will be exploring the different sounds instruments make.

We will be creating our own art work in the style of Jackson Pollock.

# Communication and Language Development

We will be learning to listen, attend and concentrate during appropriate activities and in a range of different situations

# Reading
