

<u>Platform 1</u> <u>Spring 1</u> <u>Julia Donaldson's Stories</u>






These stories and their characters, will feature in the majority of work we complete this half-term.

In English this term we will be focusing on a range of stories written by Julia Donaldson.


Based on these stories we will be completing activities such as character and setting descriptions, comprehension skills, retelling stories in our own words and writing alternative endings to stories.

We will also continue to work on individual targets in Phonics and Grammar, Punctuation and














In Maths, we will be continuing our work on place value, number and using these skills to do more complex 2-digit addition and subtraction problems.


We will continue applying our knowledge of the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.

We will also be continuing to work on mindfulness and introducing yoga.

As you can see from our half-term topic overview, we have lots of learning and fun activities planned for this half-term all based around our topic of Julia Donaldson's stories.

We wished a fond farewell to Mr. Hall at the end of the Autumn Term and welcome Miss Noble to the team. Miss Noble previously worked in The Platform for a term so she already knows and understands our rules and routines and is really looking forward to working with the children.
