


Spring 1 Who Are We?


In English we will be exploring and writing setting descriptions, metaphor poetry and non-chronological reports.

We will be reading the novel 'Dangerous Reality' by Malorie Blackman



recalling and using equivalences between simple fractions, decimals and percentages in different contexts and solve problems that require finding percentages of whole numbers. We will also solve problems involving the calculation and conversion of units of measure, convert between units of measure and find the area and perimeter of shapes.


In Maths we will be focusing on



In computing our topic will be 'Stocks and shares'. We will learn to create simple spreadsheets to model real life problems. We will also construct and interpret different graphs using spreadsheet software.



In Science our unit is 'Evolution and Inheritance'. We will research how living things have changed over time and how fossils provide information about things that lived millions of years ago. We will also learn about how living things produce offspring of the same kind and how they vary from the parent.



In RE we will be studying Hinduism, particularly the 4 stages of life (Ashramas). We will look at beliefs in the cycle of reincarnation.

In PE we will be developing dance sequences in different styles and link these to timings.

We will also be developing skills of throwing and catching and tactics in rugby.



In PHSE, we will be focusing on emotional health and well-being. We will talk about our feelings using appropriate language and learn to resolve differences by looking for alternatives.

In Music we will be studying the song 'I'll be there'. This will involve listening to and appraising music as well as singing in groups/harmony.
