In English we are going to be reading the 'Tabby McTat', 'We're all Wonders' and 'Lost and Found'.

We are going to be writing recounts about our experiences in school and character's experiences in our stories. We will also be writing our own stories based upon familiar tales.

In PE we will be focusing on developing our fundamental skills and developing our ability throw and catch accurately. We will develop our skills and apply them to game situations.

## Spring 1

In Maths we will be focusing on developing our knowledge of numbers and place value to 50. We will be working creatively to explore these numbers.

We will learn how to represent these amounts effectively, order numbers, and count forwards and backwards confidently.

Using our knowledge of numbers we will develop our ability to add and subtract amounts. We will learn to read and write number sentences.



In Music we are going to be focusing on blues, Bhangra and folk music. We will listen to a range of music by known composers and use their music to influence our own compositions and performances. We are going to explore using Chrome Music Lab when we transcribe our own compositions.



In Art we are going to be exploring artists Henry Matisse and Jurt Schwitters. We will explore their work and create our own collage pieces inspired by them.

In Science our focus is going to be learning about everyday materials.

We will carry out investigations and observations of materials in our everyday lives. We will classify objects by the materials they are made of and be finding out which materials are the best to make a winter coat.



In RE we are going to learn about the Hindu faith and how Hindu's show their belief in their God. We will also discuss the impact their belief has on their life and the choices they make.

In PSHE we will be focusing on how to keep safe in familiar surroundings and to understand that household products can be harmful if they are not used correctly. We will be focusing on the importance of our individuality and how unique we all are. Year 1 will also learn about those who work in the community around us.
